BULLET PROOF MAN advanced four wide, made the lead on the turn dropping to the inside, was all out to last. FLEETWOOD MAX off a step slow, bumped then in tight, moved up three wide, closed with a rush. VANASTASH bore in and bumped with FLEETWOOD MAX at the start, steadily advanced three and four wide, had no late bid. SHIMMERING ECHO failed to menace, four and five wide. COMMAND APPROVAL found his best stride late, three wide. LARRUP bumped at the start, passed tiring rivals four wide. EIGHT LEFT prompted the issue inside, lacked a late response. EAGLE BEAGLE set the pace on the rail, gave way around the turn. RELLIUS showed early speed, steadily faded. SPYDEY pressed the pace inside, tired.
