GAME CHANGER was hustled to the front three wide approaching the quarter pole, drew clear saving ground through the turn and held well under steady stretch encouragement. JOE THE PLUMBER chased the pace toward the rail, was no threat to the winner though dug in for place. RED HOT DAY had a short brief early lead five wide while between horses, was shuffled back two deep into the turn and finished evenly for show. SECOND TO NONE chased the pace inside, was boxed near the rail through the turn and ran evenly in the stretch. ROYAL DANGER gave chase two deep before leveling off in the stretch. GOLDSTREAM MINER showed no speed about the three path, eased out entering the stretch but had nothing further. REGENERATED chased the pace from the four path and proved empty in the stretch. BETCHA showed no speed inside. INTO THE NIGHT lost contact early.
