Footnotes

BRIMSTONE ISLAND quickly moved to the lead two deep, rated the pace inside from the five eighths pole, was prompted nearing the five sixteenths and while holding on under steady encouragement, appeared to be sore upon return. MR. TIME TO GO lunged and stumbled at the break, settled off the pace about the three path, bid three wide nearing the quarter pole, drifted outward under a left hand drive leaving the final turn and leveled off from there. WHY SHIRLEY WHY, well back outside, bid toward the quarter pole, rounded the final turn in the four path and gained mildly to show before leveling off. HIDEAWAY MOON, well back and off the rail, improved mildly down the lane. SKIPPY DUDE chased the pace from the inside but had little left rounding the final turn. CHAMP'S METAL, a step slow to break, rated with the early pace two deep, gave chase from the five sixteenths pole and appeared a close factor to the middle of the final turn before beginning to fade. RAVEN'S LUCK dropped back from a brief early lead inside to stalk the pace on the first turn then lacked significant response leaving the three eighths pole. BROTHER BRADEN was not a factor. MOLINAROITALYSFORT, off the pace toward mid track, was through after three eighths.
