**Footnotes**

SOUND AFFAIR rated back toward the outside, rallied to the lead three wide past the quarter pole, duelled clear into the lane and widened under steady handling. BLACKBERRY WINTER settled off the pace and off the rail, bid with the winner approaching the quarter pole, had aim at the rail entering the stretch and while relenting the win, held well in place. WHITE POST settled off the pace inside, bid toward the five sixteenths pole, took show into the lane and just lasted. WILD CAPTAIN BOB came away slowly brushing the gate, entered the first turn five wide, settled back in mid track then passed tiring rivals in an even finish. KID KEARNY GABE rated back outside, bid nearing the quarter pole, rounded the final turn six wide then leveled off in the lane. UNCLE BOB'S VIPER checked from tight quarters between rivals into the first turn, settled off the pace off the rail, made a bid approaching the quarter pole then leveled off in the lane. CLEVER REMARK angled in entering the first turn, settled back off the rail, made a mild bid approaching the quarter pole then leveled off rounding the final turn. WESTERN FRONTIER showed no speed well back and off the rail. SEND A SPIRIT was pinched back at the heels of Uncle Bob's Viper into the first turn then raced well back. GOTTSCHALK rated a clear lead inside, came under a drive toward the quarter pole, quickly gave up control then readily faded on the final turn.
