Footnotes

BOB AND RON stumbled to his nose leaving the gate, settled back from the early pace off the rail, pulled toward contention through the opening turn, steadily progressed to take over three wide nearing the quarter pole, was soon clear and under an aggressive hand ride to widen down the lane. FAST PUNISHMENT settled just off the pace about the four path, picked up the chase from the three eighths pole, moved to second entering the stretch and dug in to hold that position well. POLITICAL PROMISE settled off the early pace toward mid track, gave chase nearing the three eighths pole, saved some ground on the final turn and was along late for show. PAM'S LUC rated with the pace two deep, challenged for control leaving the three eighths pole, dueled to a slim brief lead while between horses at the five sixteenths pole and continued a close factor through the final turn before leveling off. DOWNBYTHERIVER rated a slim lead inside, was pressured leaving the three eighths pole, caught past the five sixteenths and leveled off rounding the final turn. KYRIE ELEISON FA saved ground and was through early. GOLDEN HEART was not a factor.
