FEISTY ALBERT steadied at the heels of Roccamo entering the first turn, started a four wide bid leaving the half mile pole, dug in three wide through the final turn to reach the front in late yard then edged clear toward the wire. SMARTER HALF accelerated to the front for inside position, rated the pace through the backstretch, came under pressure at the quarter pole and dug in with the advantage to late stretch before yielding. ROCCAMO rated close inside, gave chase from the five sixteenths pole and remained in range through the final turn before leveling off. TOP PARTNER, well back off the rail, bid nearing the quarter pole, rounded the final turn about the four path and finished evenly. MANION raced outside and was outrun. DANIEL'S BOY rated close to the early pace inside, was boxed in the opening turn then faded down the backstretch. DAUPHIN chased the early pace off the rail, moved toward mid track entering the backstretch and showed nothing further. WAR ROOM rated close three wide, gave chase from the three eighths pole then faded on the final turn.
