Footnotes

DESERT BABY settled back toward mid track, saved ground with a bid near the five sixteenths pole, eased out in the upper stretch to resume her drive five wide and reached the front in the final strides. SHORT BUT SWEET was hustled to the front to rate a short lead inside, came under pressure nearing the five sixteenths pole, lugged in toward midstretch then caught the final strides. CONJOB rated close off the rail, was boxed in through the final turn, had aim at the rail entering the stretch but was pinched back a sixteenth away and finished evenly. INDIAN SUGAR rated close about the four path, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole, circled the final turn four wide, exchanged light contact with Easter Rising from the top of the stretch to the sixteenth pole and finished evenly. YACHT HUND rated just off the pace off the rail, gave chase leaving the seven sixteenths pole, entered the lane six wide and finished well. EASTER RISING rated close off the rail, picked up the chase toward the five sixteenths pole, exchanged light contact with Indian Sugar from the eighth pole to midstretch then leveled off nearing the wire. HALF A NOTION, off the pace toward the outside, showed little response while five wide on the final turn. SPEAKING OF LUCK settled back inside, bid nearing the three eighths pole, closed to a boxed in position midway on the final turn, lacked room to the head of the lane then steadied again midstretch and leveled off. MISS DANI KAY came away awkwardly then was not a factor. A stewards inquiry and subsequent claim of foul against the rider of Short But Sweet, lodged by the rider of Conjob, resulted in the disqualification to third of the former, for closing ranks on the latter in the upper to midstretch.
