Footnotes

PUSH N. BOOTS rated in good position early while inside, closed incrementally through the backstretch, assumed control three wide near the eighth pole then dug in gamely, under pressure from the runner-up, to last. LONG SHADOW rated off the pace inside angled out looking for room nearing the eighth pole, drew close with a sixteenth to go but finished evenly from there. MAKE A WESH rated off the pace off the rail, made his move angling outward on the final turn and was inching closer late. MAJOR DANGER, unhurried off the rail, bid on the final turn then leveled off through the lane. SONG OF WAR contested the early pace while inside and had little left in the stretch. VALID TRIP contested the early pace two deep and weakened toward the three sixteenths pole. KNOX COUNTY and HIGH GORDON were never factors.
