GET READY GO advanced six wide down the backstretch, made a slim lead on the turn then was all out to last. MCNAMARA pressed the issue four wide, gained the rail on the turn, missed in a strong effort. BRADDOCK STREET tardy at the start, advanced three and four wide, lacked a late response. COOL BEANS set the pace under pressure three wide, fell back around the turn. VALENTINO'S BOY within striking distance three wide, eased out five wide on the turn, had no late bid. WOHALI stalked the leaders from the inside, lacked the needed rally. MY WHIM MY WAY was no factor on the inside. COTTON HEARTED made a middle move five wide along the backstretch, flattened out. RIDE THE RANGE forced the issue from the inside, tired. HELLO BOP a pace factor four wide, had little left after a half.
