QUALITY JACK bore out making contact with Dont Rob Bob on the chute, hustled clear past the seven sixteenths pole to set the pace inside, was driven into the lane and kept to steady stretch handling. HE'S GREAT gave close early chase about the three path, dropped back near the rail rounding the turn and finished evenly to be second best. BIG BRANCH lugged inward on the chute, chased the pace toward mid track, rounded the turn in the five path and engaged in a late duel for show. KING TEPU chased the pace inside though was outfinished in a late duel for show. DONT ROB BOB, bumped then pinched back on the chute, dropped well back from the pace and settled about the three path to give chase. MISSILE ASSAULT, reluctant to load, chased the pace while angling toward mid track but leveled off saving some ground on the turn. UARESOGOOD lacked speed toward mid track. CAROLING MIA, briefly close, faded off the rail down the backstretch. MACON'S HARD ROCK, pinched back on the chute, lacked speed. CORUM VOBIS showed no speed outside.
