Footnotes

THE REAL PRINCE pressured the pace from the inside, eased outside the pacesetter entering the stretch and dug in for the lead the final yards. J T MOORE was hustled with the early lead three wide, saved ground on the turn, dug in hard with stout handling through the stretch, weakened to the winner's tenacity nearing the wire and just lasted for place. T QUE chased the pace inside, was shuffled back on the rail through the turn, angled five wide entering the stretch and just missed place in a strong finish. SNAKE CHARMER chased the pace about the four path, saved ground through the turn, angled to the rail at the top of the stretch, was eased three wide past the sixteenth pole and leveled off the remainder. ALYJEN'S SPEED chased the pace from the inside, angled five wide into the stretch and finished evenly. MEMO MON chased the early pace toward the outside, had his heels clipped nearing the turn, took aim three wide into the stretch but leveled off the remainder. DIAMOND PARK was outrun. GRAN PATRON was shuffled back early and not a factor. FUNKY COUNTRY leapt a fallen horse nearing the turn and lost his rider in the process. WARRIOR RUN clipped the heels of Memo Man and fell nearing the turn. The stewards reviewed the incident into the turn before posting the official.
