DANCING VALIANT quickly established a clear lead and inside position, rated the pace to the middle of the final turn then widened with only mild hand urging to win easily. TODAY AND ALWAYS kept close to the pace two deep, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, proved no match for the winner but finished evenly and lasted for place. MR. KWOK settled back off the rail, bid at the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn in the four path and finished evenly. LOUD RAVENS stalked the early pace three wide, gave chase from the three eighths pole then leveled out in the lane. BIG ROUGE, well back and off the rail, made a bid leaving the three eighths pole, angled outward on the final turn, entered the stretch about the four path but had little further. BUCKSTON CALLING settled just off the pace inside, gave chase from the three eighths pole but lacked a response on the final turn. PREMIER'S WHINNY, four wide the opening turn, was kept off the early pace toward mid track, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole then weakened on the final turn. BRADDOCK STREET raced well back off the rail and had no rally. CLASSY MINISTER raced five wide the opening turn then never factored.
