Footnotes

ENDLESS WISH rated off the early pace outside, closed toward contention through the backstretch, came three wide on the final turn, dug in for the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and drew clear approaching the wire. ALL I NEED TO KNOW stalked the early pace two deep, moved to the front near the seven sixteenths pole, contested the rail on the final turn, held the advantage in the upper stretch then yielded nearing the sixteenth pole. ROSES IN THE PARK stalked the pace off the rail, held aim under steady encouragement on the final turn but leveled off in the lane. CIVIL DANCER rated off the pace off the rail, bid mildly on the final turn then leveled off in the stretch. BREADMAN'S HONEY saved ground the opening turn, edged closer outside through the backstretch then had nothing left in the stretch. SOFT PETALS was outrun saving ground. CATS BID rated a short lead inside the first turn, dropped back leaving the seven sixteenths pole then faded approaching the final turn. LILIBETS CASTLE loomed a close early factor then stayed within range down the backstretch before weakening on the final turn. MARGARET'S RUBY never factored.
