SAYS ME pressed the pace three wide, gained a slim lead in the upper stretch, was all out to last. GARNER KEY set the pace under heavy pressure, dug in gamely in the stretch. PRETTY VALAY rallied on the inside around the turn, angled out for the drive, finished strong. NO MORE TEARS stalked the pace four and five wide, finished well. TANTA MARIE GOLD bid along the inside on the turn, closed ground willingly. CLASSY CHRIS five wide backstretch, came three wide on the turn, lacked a late response. TRIBAL (IRE) failed to menace three and four wide. BLAINE'S SONG close up, had no rally. BLUE FROSTY MUG was used up after six furlongs.
