**Footnotes**

JAEGERMANN pressed the pace two wide, took command near the five-sixteenths marker, vied between foes around the far turn, continued on his left lead in the lane, was briefly headed near the sixteenth pole but fought back inside of AWESOME DAVID to prevail. AWESOME DAVID was bumped just after the start, settled off the pace while parked four wide around the first turn, rallied four deep around the far turn, continued to gain through upper stretch, briefly led in midstretch and hung. BROOKS IN TOWN lacked speed while racing four wide early, advanced three wide between foes around the far turn, split rivals in upper stretch and finished well inside of the winner. SIGNATURE RUN raced along the rail around both turns and lacked the needed rally. CLEVER CAT DIAMOND failed to menace while racing two and three wide. PRIMA FACIE stalked the pace three wide and came up empty. CHANGE FOR GOLD was bumped just after the start, raced three wide and was no threat. THE BUTLER DID IT stalked the pace inside and tired around the far turn. GRIZZLY BAY set the pace along the rail and tired around the far turn. GETAWAY MONEY was no factor while racing two wide.
