HEAVENLY MONSTER prompted the pace four wide then in a long drive was all out to prevail. WIN FOR DESTINY saved ground, angled six wide for the drive and closed with a rush to just miss. HAWAIIAN HONOUR advanced three wide, finished strongly but came up short in a strong effort. J'S SORITE RIZZI pressed the pace just off the rail but was out finished. QUIET MANNER forced the pace on the rail, lacked a closing bid. VANISHING WOLF set the pace under heavy pressure, weakened in the drive. RUNNING HEEL stalked the pace three and four wide, finished with good energy. DIPSYDOODLE DANCER within striking distance four and five wide, lacked the needed rally. BAKER'S GOLD WON showed early speed then had little left for the drive. SECRET WAY six wide along the backstretch, was no factor.
