Footnotes

FAST FLING stalked the pace toward the rail, eased four wide past the three sixteenths pole, came under a drive into the stretch and steadily closed in an outward drift to get up and draw clear late yards. WILD ROVER moved to the lead three wide toward the three eighths pole, set a pressured pace from that point, ran clear on the final turn, was caught in late yards and just held on for place. ROADHOUSE ROMEO settled back inside, came under a drive midway on the final turn, lacked room most of the stretch but found room inside the drifting winner to finish well and just missed place. TIME IS NOW, five wide the first turn, stalked the pace from the half mile pole, was at nearly even terms three wide at the three eighths and continued in close chase to the lane before leveling off. HYDES R US took over angling in for the lead three wide at the five eighths pole, was overcome at the three eighths pole but continued in close chase to late stretch before leveling off. WILLEECADOO showed no speed outside, bid mildly on the backstretch then leveled out on the final turn. BRAAK'S DEPUTY showed no speed outside. DUAL INDIAN, four wide the opening turn, saved ground afterward. PROSPECT BREWING stalked the pace two deep but was through early.
