DOC'S DANCER quickly cleared the field to set the pace inside, was rated to the five sixteenths pole, pressured from there, driven into the lane and under steady encouragement to last. ROCKY MARSH, off the pace outside, bid toward the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn four wide and dueled through the stretch for place. SPANISH AFFAIR chased the pace inside, eased around a tiring rival approaching the quarter pole, came through the final turn three wide then outfinished in the duel for place. LONG SHADOW rated close about the four path, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, had aim in the upper stretch but leveled off the final sixteenth. NICK'S MONSTER chased the early pace from the inside, eased five wide rounding the final turn and finished well in mid track. BIG AND BRIGHT settled just off the pace inside, picked up the chase leaving the three eighths pole, ran up to the heels of the waning Di Cola's Town midway on the final turn, lacked room to midstretch but finished well when clear. LUCA'S WIND DANCER raced well back toward mid track. DRESSED UP showed no speed outside and saved ground on the final turn to no effect. DI COLAS TOWN stalked the pace off the rail, had aim leaving the three eighths pole and continued the chase to the five sixteenths before fading. FREDDY BEAR settled close to the early pace two deep and between horses but broke down just past the half mile pole.
