**Footnotes**

SON OF A BEAR stalked the pace inside through the opening half, raced four wide around the far turn, took the lead inside the sixteenth pole and prevailed under a drive. NO BRAKES bumped with CONFEDERATE SILVER just after the start, lacked speed while racing three wide around the first turn, circled six wide around the far turn and finished strongly to gain the place. TWENTY HAWKS dueled along the rail, cut the corner to take a clear lead into the lane, was collared inside the sixteenth pole but held well to preserve the show. LOVE TO THE MAX dueled two wide between rivals to upper stretch and weakened. DISCLOSURE was off slow, raced four wide and rallied belatedly. GOOD GENERAL stalked the pace four wide around the first turn, bid three deep leaving the half-mile pole, vied down the backstretch and three wide into the far turn and faded from the three-sixteenths pole. EDDIE C. saved ground around the first turn, raced six wide around the far turn and failed to menace. EXTREME DREAM stalked the pace three wide and dropped back while racing five wide around the far turn. CONFEDERATE SILVER bumped with NO BRAKES just after the start, raced three wide and lacked a bid. WINGED HERO raced five wide around the first turn, angled in leaving the half-mile pole and had no response.
