**Footnotes**

LEOBUSTER up close early, rated off the pace along the inside down the backstretch, rallied to contention on the turn then under a strong drive was up in the final strides. SPRINGS ROAD prompted the issue three wide, made a clear lead around the turn, led until the final strides. STRAIGHT THUNDER prompted the pace from the inside, finished well. TERMSOFENGAGEMENT steadied off heels after the start, bid three wide on the turn, finished strongly. NOSTALGIC BID set the pace on a clear lead, remained a factor around the turn, weakened in the drive. CRAFTY BEAR four wide, lacked the needed rally. TEXAS HOLLADAY five wide along the backstretch, angled to the rail on the turn then was easing through the stretch.
