Footnotes

BLAZE OF HONOR chased the early pace toward mid track, dueled to the front past the three sixteenths pole and dug in under a determined drive to best the efforts of Magnetizer. MAGNETIZER, hustled along to set a pressured pace two deep, edged clear approaching the five sixteenths pole, was headed past the three sixteenths pole and dug in gamely to late stretch before leveling off. OUR BOY K C, well back from the early pace toward mid track, saved some ground on the turn, was bumped midstretch, angled to the inside from that point and finished evenly to show. CAPABLE NATIVE chased the pace about the three path then outfinished for show late yards. PRINCE KILLMAIN chased the pace toward mid track through the backstretch, saved ground nearing the turn, angled out entering the stretch then lugged in making contact with Our Boy K C a sixteenth away and leveled off. PLEASURE SHOW pressured the pace from the inside to the head of the lane before weakening. COUNTRY FEVER chased the pace outside most of the backstretch then saved some ground on the turn. BOOGALOO GEORGE, a step slow at the break, chased the early pace toward the inside, eased out nearing the turn, entered the stretch about the five path and had little left in the lane. HIGHLY PRIZED was never a factor.
