Footnotes

GIN MAKES YA SIN stalked the pace two deep from the eleven sixteenths pole, started a bid leaving the three eighths, took over at the five sixteenths, was soon clear and widened under steady stretch handling. SHEPARD raced well back from the early pace while saving ground, bid in the three path nearing the three eighths pole, dueled for place just inside the eighth pole but had to settle for second best. MIDNIGHT LAUGH rated just off the pace about the four path, gave chase leaving the half mile pole, raced rear the rail rounding the final turn then leveled off down the lane. BACK BEAT, well back outside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, saved ground through the final turn and finished evenly. HE'S MINE rated off the pace off the rail, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole and raced evenly through the lane. TRACK TELLING moved to the lead inside past the eleven sixteenths pole, was pressured from the three eighths, caught a pole further on and faded near the rail rounding the final turn. HITTER'S ALLEY rated off the early pace in the four and five paths, made a middle move through the backstretch then weakened rounding the final turn. CITY BEAR, off the pace toward the inside, showed no response. COKER SPRING, no factor toward the outside, saved ground on the final turn. DEVILISH BOY, no factor toward mid track, saved ground on the final turn.
