Footnotes

CRACKER JACK DAD rated close to the early pace two deep, pulled himself to the front approaching the seven sixteenths pole, was soon clear, driven into the lane and held well with steady urging. SHOOTMETOTHEMOON rated a short lead off the rail, was caught nearing the seven sixteenths pole, gave chase from that point, proved no match for the winner and just lasted in place. ALEX A FORTIORI, well back and off the rail early, eased toward the outside leaving the half mile pole, started a bid near the five sixteenths, rounded the final turn in the four path, steadily improved down the lane and just missed place. BEE REGAL, seven wide the opening turn, settled back outside, saved some ground making a bid nearing the final turn then leveled off at the rail down the lane. ROCKY CAFE exchanged contact with Big Machine leaving the gate, rounded the opening turn six wide, rated just off the pace outside, gave chase from the three eighths pole then leveled off in the four path of the final turn. ITALIAN GUY saved ground off the pace then faded through the backstretch. MAIN MAN SAM, five wide the first turn, moved to close contention four wide nearing the five eighths pole, gave chase through the backstretch then faded on the final turn. BIG MACHINE exchanged contact with Rocky Cafe leaving the gate, was shuffled back at that point and never a factor. BLACK TIE DINNER settled just off the pace inside, gave chase leaving the half mile pole then steadied and faded from the five sixteenths pole. PLEASURE PEAKS was not a factor racing toward the outside.
