Footnotes

ROYAL EAVESDROPPER, bumped twice early, chased the pace in the three path, started a drive midway on the turn and dug in under determined handling to get up the final strides. DISTINCT BY DESIGN pressed the pace two deep, dueled to a slim advantage past the quarter pole, dug in from the head of the lane but was outfinished the final strides. CANE HILL TERRACE broke out making contact with Squeaks Magee, chased the pace inside, came between horses in the upper stretch and finished well in a three way photo. BIG RED RIVER chased the pace inside, showed little response at the rail rounding the turn but finished evenly in a hard drive. BIG TREE FALL HARD bore in making solid contact with the winner near the half mile pole, was knocked off stride as a result, continued the chase outside through the backstretch, rounded the turn five wide then leveled off in the stretch. SQUEAKS MAGEE, jostled at the start, was bumped outward and into the winner soon afterward, gave chase toward mid track, saved some ground on the turn then leveled out in the stretch. WILDCAT APPROVAL raced well back and inside, angled out from the three sixteenths pole and weakened in the lane. UNLIKELY HERO set a pressured pace inside, contested a disadvantage at the rail past the quarter pole then gave way in the upper stretch.
