Footnotes

CHRIS'S SYMPHONY settled back toward the outside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, improved five wide rounding the final turn and dug in under a hardy stretch drive to get up the final stride. STONEWALLING settled close to the early pace off the rail, angled outward with a bid toward the quarter pole, rounded the final turn in the six path, dueled to a slim brief lead between horses in late stretch but was outfinished the final stride. AIRSTREAM DRIVER settled off the early pace about the three path, bid angling to the outside leaving the first turn, moved to the front at the five sixteenths pole, saved ground on the final turn and held the advantage to late stretch before giving way. FUZZYWUZZYWUZABEAR rated close three wide, gave chase past the three eighths pole then leveled out down the lane. NICK'S BLITZ stalked the pace two deep, took a slim lead while between horses at the half mile pole, was caught at the five sixteenths then leveled off at the rail on the final turn. WHITE POST settled back toward the inside, gave chase leaving the five eighths pole, swerved out from the heels of both Farley Wink and Gingerbread Fred nearing the head of the lane then passed tiring rivals outside. FARLEY WINK rated close about the three path, started a bid nearing the quarter pole, came in making contact with Gingerbread Fred approaching the head of the lane, leveled off from that point and returned with the saddle slipped back. GINGERBREAD FRED held a short lead inside the opening turn, was caught approaching the half mile pole, continued in close chase through the backstretch, faded rounding the final turn then bumped off stride nearing the head of

the lane. FOXFIELD DRIVE rated close in the five path, gave chase leaving the first turn, faded losing ground on the final turn then forced out nearing the top of the stretch. CASTLE CLOSE, well back off the rail, was shut off and roughed while veering out from the heels of White Post approaching the top of the lane. After a stewards inquiry, Farley Wink was disqualified to last place for causing the incident nearing the head of the lane which in turn started a chain reaction involving the horses trailing him.
