Footnotes

ATLANTA forced the issue four wide, made the lead on the turn, drew off through the stretch under a drive. SHOWMETHETRICK five wide down the backstretch, bid three wide on the turn, closed with a rush through the lane. STRAIGHT OUT stalked the leaders four and five wide, lacked a late response. WIND WHISPER within striking distance three and four wide, lacked a closing bid. PERFECT WAY broke in the air, saved ground, finished strongly. CAPTAIN KIRKLAND inside along the backstretch, swung out five wide around the turn, finished well. GREEN STORM pressed the pace three wide, weakened in the drive. QUICK SHOW off a step slow, found his best stride late while six wide. SPEEDY SAMMY set the early pace, remained a factor on the turn, faded through the stretch. BO CHARITY prompted the issue from the inside, had little left for the drive.
