**Footnotes**

VERO BEACH gave chase about the three path, saved ground past the five sixteenths pole, improved at the rail rounding the turn, dueled to the front midstretch and dug in under a determined drive to hold on. D'FLYING PULGA engaged in close chase inside, drifted out while taking the edge entering the lane and dueled gamely with the advantage to midstretch before reluctantly ceding. AWOW, in distant chase outside, rounded the turn mid track then dug in through the lane in a strong finish for show. YANKEE BABE gave chase toward mid track then leveled off in deep stretch. JIVE PARTNER chased the early pace outside, saved ground nearing mid turn and ran evenly down the lane. FARNELL'S ALLEY chased the pace from the outside, saved some ground on the turn and passed tiring rivals in mid track. SOFIE S set a fast pace about the four path, mostly of her own initiative, then bore outward rounding the turn and weakened from the head of the lane. DECORATED WELL came away a step slow and raced well back. ICY LOVER, well back outside, saved ground approaching the turn, checked from the rail at the three sixteenths pole, was unsaddled on the turn and vanned off. COLLEGE STATION was urged along inside to chase the pace then checked past the five sixteenths pole and faded.
