GLORIOUS SUNRISE moved for clear early control inside, came under pressure from the three eighths pole, contested a slim disadvantage through the final turn but dug in determinedly from the head of the lane to eke out a narrow lead inside the sixteenth pole. OUT TO PLEASE stalked the winner off the rail, moved to a slim lead at the three eighths pole, contested the final turn and dug in gamely from the head of the lane before grudgingly ceding inside the sixteenth pole. BELFAST DANCER rated off the pace two deep, started his drive inside the three eighths pole, eased three wide entering the lane and closed to the outside girth of the runner-up before running out of ground. FOOD FOR THOUGHT, unhurried off the rail, bid nearing the final turn then leveled out through the lane. ROAD NOT TRAVELED, unhurried inside, eased out through the stretch but made no significant bid. NO BODY'S SON was not a factor. VENABLO, awkward at the break, rated off the early pace inside then faded at the rail on the final turn. MOUNT BREVETOR, off the early pace toward mid track, showed no response to hard use from the half mile pole.
