TACTICAL ASSAULT raced unhurriedly while well back and two deep, started a drive leaving the three eighths pole, angled five wide through the final turn and steadily advanced to get up the closing strides. DISGUISE rated a slim lead off the rail, moved clear to save ground at the seven sixteenths pole, was pressured on the final turn, appeared to flatten stride from the sixteenth pole but lasted for place. AWESOME CHARLIE, off the pace about the four path, came under pressure near the quarter pole and closed well to deep stretch before running out of ground. WILLIE BAGS rated close inside, bid from the quarter pole then leveled off through the lane. TRISTEN'S MAMBO, unhurried off the rail, started a drive leaving the three eighths pole, was carried six wide on the final turn and finished evenly widest. MOOKIE'S BROTHER, four wide the opening turn, rated close two deep on the backstretch, started a drive nearing the quarter pole though lacked further response while losing ground into the lane. ICE BERLIN saved ground while off the pace. ACROSS THE WIND was through early.
