Footnotes

TWINVICTUS drifted out making contact with Dont Rob Bob on the chute, was urged to the front three wide toward the three eighths pole, raced clear past the pole, widened on the turn and held well with steady urging. GOT THE URGE, briefly clear, gave chase off the rail nearing the three eighths pole, proved no match for the winner but dug in to duel for place. MIDWAY SURF gave chase inside and was outfinished in the duel for place. DONT ROB BOB, brushed on the chute, gave chase in mid track, rounded the turn three wide, was carried five wide into the stretch then leveled off. KING TEPU was jostled at the start, gave chase in the three path, raced hemmed in through the turn, forced his way out entering the stretch then leveled off in the drive. TAMARINDO saved ground to give chase, was boxed at the rail through the turn, continued pursuit into the stretch but came up empty. ROVIN GAMBLER chased the early pace from the outside then saved ground through the turn. DYLAN FIRST was only briefly close, gave chase in the three path but was through early. MR. BUSHWHACKER hesitated a full length at the start then trailed the competition.
