THE HOLY ONE led throughout, drew off around the turn then was ridden out through the stretch. ROBIN DES TRUE prompted the issue along the rail and was second best. EMILY'S SECRETBEAR bumped at the start, advanced just off the rail but was no match for the winner. LUNAR'S SERENITY bore out and bumped with EMILY'S SECRETBEAR at the start, was within striking distance three wide, had no rally. SNUNNER stalked the leaders on the rail, failed to respond. MELODAR pressed the pace three wide, tired. GUSSIE'S SECRET never was a factor, three and four wide. MOULIN D'OR forced the issue four wide, had little left for the drive. SIDE SHOW showed little, lost contact with field on the turn then was eased through the stretch.
