Footnotes

MANDORLA stalked the pace three wide between rivals around the first turn, vied between foes down the backstretch, angled to the rail nearing the far turn, vied inside of CHAMP'S METAL around most of that bend, drew clear when that foe drifted out into the lane and held sway under a drive. OVERCASTER settled off the pace in the three path, advanced three wide around the far turn, was floated five wide when CHAMP'S METAL drifted out entering the stretch and finished strongly to cut much of the gap. WILDCAT HIGH was unhurried in the three path early, raced four wide around the far turn and was along for the show. WITT'S ROAD saved ground and passed tiring rivals. CHAMP'S METAL stalked the pace four wide between rivals, bid outside of and in tandem with the winner down the backstretch, pressed that foe around most of the far turn, drifted out entering the lane and tired. HOLD ON ALLEN dueled two wide between rivals around the first turn and tired leaving the three-eighths pole. SARTORE dueled along the rail and gave way nearing the far turn. A. P. CONQUISTADOR was outrun inside. CAFE KOMODO stalked the pace five wide around the first turn, faltered near the three-eighths pole and retreated while still five wide around the far turn.
