Footnotes

CATTAIL RUN rated close off the rail, was boxed in near the quarter pole, angled three wide with a bid from that point, dug in for control midstretch and drew clear nearing the wire. RUNAWAY VALAY, four wide the opening turn, stalked the pace about the three path, rallied to the front inside the quarter pole, dueled clear midway on the final turn, relinquished control a sixteenth away and just lasted in place. RED VICTORY settled off the early pace toward mid track, bid to contention approaching the final turn, entered the stretch five wide, finished well and just missed place. CADENCE'S ACCOLADE rated the pace inside, came under pressure toward the five sixteenths pole, dueled into the final turn, yielded control at the three sixteenths pole then leveled off from the sixteenth. RAINBOW JUDY, off the pace and off the rail, bid leaving the half mile pole, had aim in the upper stretch but leveled off from there. BRING IT ON SALLY rated back toward mid track then lacked a response on the backstretch. BELLA UNO was kept off the pace off the rail, bid mildly down the backstretch, had aim on the final turn then weakened in the stretch. TACTICAL SARA was no factor while saving ground. MISS ADDY KISS, five wide the first turn, raced well back toward the outside, bid six wide toward the quarter pole then weakened in the stretch. VIVACIOUS ANNA was not a factor while saving ground.
