CROSSROAD'S GOLD dueled from the inside for the early lead, dueled up the backstretch, shook loose entering the second turn and was clear late while kept to task. JUDGE MARSHALL stalked the early pace from the outside, advanced entering the second turn but could not reach the winner. MAKE A WESH outrun early, advanced outside, responded and finished well. ROMANISATION chased the early pace inside but had nothing left for the drive. QUIET NO MORE forced the pace from between foes but had no late response. SELECT CHEROKEE dueled from the outside early, dueled up the backstretch but tired. CHIEF OSHKOSH chased the early pace from between foes and tired. LEEWAY DANCER was no factor. VIEW MY REAR had a steady fade.
