Footnotes

PARKER'SGOLDENECAT stalked the pace two deep, took over approaching the five sixteenths pole, moved clear on the final turn and finished well with only moderate handling. SILVER SPIKE steadied at the start, rated back inside, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole and finished at the rail, a clear second best. PANTASTIC rated close in the three path, came under pressure approaching the quarter pole then leveled off through the lane. GRAND ROUGE, off the pace outside, came through the final turn five wide and had no rally. J TRAIN was boxed at the heels of Middle River the opening turn, stalked the pace for a half mile, was boxed in again midway on the final turn, eased out for the drive and finished evenly. MIDDLE RIVER rated the pace inside, was pressured toward the five sixteenths pole then faded on the final turn. KARL'S RIVER CARD and RULER BOY were not factors.
