CRIMSON CHROME was hustled early to contest the pace four deep the first time through the stretch, dropped back while hung five wide into the first turn, angled into the three path leaving the five-eighths pole, commenced his bid nearing the five-sixteenths pole, reached even terms while still in the three path near the three-sixteenths pole, dueled outside of RIGHTEOUS AGAIN from there to the wire and narrowly prevailed. RIGHTEOUS AGAIN stalked the pace in the three path path around the first turn, took the lead near the seven-sixteenths pole, drew clear entering the far turn, was joined by the winner near the three-sixteenths pole, dug in gamely inside of that foe, dueled to deep stretch and and gave way grudgingly. KID COTTON set the pace along the rail around the first turn, was collared near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased the top two from the two path around the far turn and was no match for those two while holding well clear for the show. CAROLINE'S DANCER was unhurried while saving ground early, raced three wide around the far turn and was easily best of the rest. BUCKSAVER had brief speed along the rail. AUDACIOUS DIXIE chased the pace four wide around the first turn, retreated down the backstretch and continued to fade while saving ground around the far turn. MOLINARO BANKLINE was always outrun while racing four wide around the first turn and saving ground around the far turn.
