ROBB'S WARRIOR quickly took over for inside position, rated the pace to the five sixteenths pole, came under pressure from there, contested the advantage at the rail rounding the final turn, drifted outward into the stretch and dug in under a hardy drive to last. UNLIMITED BUD settled close about the three path, closed toward contention near the three eighths pole, contested the final turn two deep, was carried outward into the stretch but remained a close factor and finished well. SMOKEN BOBBE settled back from the early pace inside, came under pressure leaving the nine sixteenths pole, eased out toward the final turn and finished evenly. HE'S A PRIZE broke in, settled well back inside, eased out making a bid from the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn six wide and had little response in the stretch. CHAPEL STREET, pinched back at the start, was forced outward into the first turn, closed toward contention outside down the backstretch, had aim four wide on the final turn, was carried outward into the lane and leveled off from there. WHY NOT JOHN, bumped at the break, was bumped sharply outward into the opening turn, raced off the pace outside, moved to even terms three wide at the five sixteenths pole, continued in close chase on the final turn then weakened in the lane. BIG BAD IKE was bumped outward and into Why Not John into the first turn, raced well back and was not a factor. SIR MARION LEWIS angled in to save ground, stalked the early pace from the inside, faded from the three eighths pole then steadied at the heels of Surprise Attack near the five sixteenths pole. SURPRISE ATTACK rated close to the early pace about the three path, moved toward the inside past the five sixteenths pole then faded rounding the final turn. BIG SHOTOFTEQUILA was rank and roughed at the heels of Sir Marion Lewis into the first turn, bore outward making contact with Why Not John and no factor afterward. After posting the inquiry, the stewards also reviewed a claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of the runner-up, for interference leaving the final turn, though found insufficient cause to make a change.
