Footnotes

MR. KEEPER bobbed slightly at the break, settled back off the rail through the opening turn, improved his position down the backstretch, assumed control near the three sixteenths pole, dueled clear midway through the lane and held well under steady handling. FIRST AND BAY stalked the early pace two deep, took over into the backstretch, was managed on the front end to the quarter pole, dueled close in the upper stretch then yielded the final sixteenth. TENDORO stalked the pace about the three path, held aim from the three eighths pole and dueled close on the final turn before weakening. MASTER OF ILLUSION, unhurried off the rail, bid from the three eighths pole and finished well. SHORE TEE rated off the pace inside, ran evenly on the final turn then weakened in the stretch. BUDDY'S HOLIDAY and RIGHTEOUS TIGER were not factors. TEMPER'S DESTINY rated the pace inside to the half mile pole, was pressured toward the seven sixteenths then faded.
