TUP TAKE' PLEASE bumped at the start, pressed the pace three wide, made the lead on the turn, drew off through the stretch under a drive. GRANDE GAYEGO prompted the issue three and four wide and was second best. GREEN SPRING BOY advanced three and four wide, failed to sustain his bid. OUTSMARTING DIXIE set the pace on the rail, gave way around the turn. LIVELY REPARATIONS saved ground, eased out four wide on the turn, lacked the needed rally. RUTLEDGE STAR off a step slow then bumped at the start, forced the pace from the rail, had no late bid. WITNESS PROTECTION flashed early speed along the inside, had little left after a half. LOUD RAVENS had brief foot on the inside.
