Footnotes

ROCKINGGLENROY set the pace in the two path around the first turn, was patiently ridden when TURFMONSTER took the lead leaving the half-mile pole, dropped back inside from there to the three-sixteenths pole, swung four wide near that marker, steadily closed, took command inside the sixteenth pole and edged away under a drive. TURFMONSTER prompted the pace three wide around the first turn, took the lead early on the backstretch run, set the pace in the two path around the far turn, continued on his left lead in the lane, was collared by the winner leaving the sixteenth pole and lasted for the place. CLEVER CAT DIAMOND was devoid of speed while racing four wide around the first turn, accelerated four wide around the far turn and rallied for the show. MR. APPOMATTOX stalked the pace from the rail, bid three wide between rivals near the three-sixteenths pole and was out kicked in the lane. MOURNING ORPHAN bumped with MOHENJO DARO just after the start, never factored while racing two to four wide and broke down after the wire. MOHENJO DARO bumped with MOURNING ORPHAN just after the start, raced three wide around the first turn, saved ground around the far turn and was never a threat. TIME IS NOW chased the pace four wide and faltered around the far turn.
