Footnotes

ROYAL SKETCH stalked the top two from the three path, bid at the seven sixteenths pole to take over midway on the final turn, dueled clear inside the sixteenth pole and held on well. BRASSY STAR angled inward through the opening furlong, made contact with Lonesome Prairie leaving the eleven sixteenths pole, settled off the pace about the three path, bid leaving the three eighths pole, finished well to get place late yards and was gaining on the winner nearing the wire. FLASHY BUCKLES, off the pace inside, bid at the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn nearest the rail, eased out midstretch then outfinished for place. E. T. ECHO rated with the early pace two deep, took over approaching the seven sixteenths pole, was pressured from that point, caught midway on the final turn though remained a close factor to midstretch before giving way. LONESOME PRAIRIE was bumped in and into the rail leaving the eleven sixteenths pole, settled well back toward the outside entering the backstretch, saved ground on the final turn, eased back out entering the stretch and finished evenly. APOTHIC RED rated a slim lead inside, was caught nearing the seven sixteenths pole, continued a close factor to the quarter, weakened from the head of the lane then shut off steadying midstretch. LAUREN'S HOLIDAY saved ground well off the pace. C M'S QUIETANN settled back outside and never factored. A stewards inquiry resulted in no change.
