Footnotes

ISLAND SKY settled well back of the early leaders toward mid track, started a bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn four wide and dug in under a steady drive to get up in closing yards. DESTINED TO SHINE rated close inside, took aim leaving the three eighths pole, came under a drive at the quarter, was carried outward into the lane, dueled to a slim brief lead inside the sixteenth pole then outfinished the final yards. OLYMPIC STREET settled off the early pace off the rail, picked up the chase from the half mile pole, steadied briefly at the five sixteenths pole, angled inward nearing the quarter and improved to late stretch before flattening stride. HIT A HOMER rated a short lead off the rail, came under pressure leaving the five sixteenths pole, steadied while losing ground entering the stretch but dug in from there with the advantage to the sixteenth pole before leveling off. BAY BUTTON BILL, well back inside, made a bid from the three eighths pole, closed to a boxed in position past the quarter pole, eased around a tiring rival through the turn but leveled off in late stretch. BOOYA SKEE DADDY, a step slow to break, was not a factor. SHORE TEE engaged in close early chase about the three path then faded while saving ground toward the quarter pole. HE'S THE KING chased the early pace about the five path but gave way after a half mile.
