OUT OF POCKET went up to prompt the pace soon after the start, gained a narrow advantage before a half, came in a bit at the eighth pole then set drew off to win as much the best. ADDED ANNUITY broker alertly to set a pressured pace for almost a half, pressed the winner while along the rail into the stretch, steadied at the eighth pole then finished second best. VIRGINIA ACCENT with the second flight into the stretch, had a mild late rally while no threat. SILVER DEPUTY PAL raced wide around the first turn then failed to reach contention. WINTERIZED STAR well placed, lacked a closing response. MATERNA trailed. LADY SOPHISTICATE was through after a half. STORMSABREWIN was outrun. UNCLE DAVE'S VISA offered little.
