**Footnotes**

BEST BOOK settled back off the rail, started a drive four wide leaving the five sixteenths pole, took over and moved clear on the final turn then widened under steady encouragement. BREW CREW, unhurried early, started her drive approaching the quarter pole, entered the stretch four wide and finished evenly to be clear in place. RIVER LIME settled back inside, bid off the rail near the quarter pole, eased three wide into the lane but leveled off the remainder. SISTER SISSY dropped back from a brief early lead to stalk the pace inside, recovered control inside the three eighths pole, faded at the rail through the final turn then weakened in the stretch. COAL VALLEY, well back off the rail, bid mildly through the final turn and finished evenly. TEXTBOOK TILLIE stalked the pace two deep, drew aim at the leader nearing the quarter pole then faded through the stretch. CORDIAL LADY was outrun toward the outside. FORMAL EXCHANGE was not a factor. RED RHAPSODY was not a factor while saving ground. LION ON THE BEACH took the lead into the first turn, set the pace to the three eighths pole but gave way readily beyond that point.
