EXQUISITE OPTION moved up four wide, dropped to the inside gaining the lead on the turn, prevailed under strong urging. SNUCK IN FOR FREE off a step slow, advanced three and four wide, closed with a rush. RINELLA STORM four and five wide, finished strongly. SUPER T set the pace on the rail, eased out three wide on the turn, faded through the stretch. HASTA LA PASTA forced the issue from the rail, lacked a late response. DECORATED WELL saved ground but had no rally. IBELIEVEINDESTINY bore out at the start, steadied then prompted the pace three wide, tired. TIZ NEXT pressed the pace from the inside, stopped after three quarters.
