Footnotes

DISCO INDY broke well from the inside to stalk the early pace, altered outside up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, gained command and was clear late while kept to task. ON ONE NOD up close early while outside rivals, dueled up the backstretch, dropped back entering the drive, responded to pressure to come again but too late. LOVE TO THE MAX dueled from the outside for the early lead, dueled up the backstretch, remained in a forward position entering the drive but could not keep pace. IN THE SPOTLIGHT outrun early, advanced outside up the backstretch, responded but was no match late. EMPEROR FUSAICHI raced evenly while five wide throughout. GENERALISSIMO was no factor. GATEWAY MOON dueled from the inside and tired.
