**Footnotes**

WICKLIFFE MAN set the pace along the rail, was content to let VIRGINIA AFFAIR lead through much of the backstretch, regained command leaving the three-eighths pole, drew clear rounding the far turn, continued on his left lead in the lane and held clear under a drive. UP TO MISCHIEF settled off the pace while racing three wide early, went five wide around the clubhouse turn, advanced three wide around the far turn and was clearly second best in the lane. VIRGINIA AFFAIR pressed the pace two wide, took the lead leaving the half-mile pole, ceded the advantage leaving the three-eighths pole, chased the winner two deep around the far turn and just lasted for the show. BROOKS IN TOWN saved ground and passed tiring rivals. CAPTAIN TEN chased the pace inside and tired around the far turn. DSPITE ALL MY RAGE was never a threat while racing three wide. AWESOME DAVID never factored while racing three wide. IN MY CROSSHAIRS was outrun inside. FIRST MINISTER had brief speed three and four wide. CHANGE FOR GOLD saved ground, stopped and was eased.
