PATTY'S PROMISE quickly took over to set the pace inside, was pressured nearing the end of the turn and held well with steady stretch handling. SALUTE ME BACK chased the early pace from the outside, saved ground approaching the quarter pole and dug in the length of the stretch to earn place. GOLDEN KAI bobbed at the break, chased the early pace toward mid track, saved ground past the three eighths pole, moved to the inside approaching the turn, lacked room nearing the end of the turn, angled four wide into the lane then outfinished in the duel for place. DON'T KNOCK KATY moved to the outside to chase the early pace, saved some ground on the turn, angled five wide into the lane then leveled off late. WINDSOR'S KATE dropped back from a brief slim lead to chase the pace toward the inside, rounded the turn nearest the rail then leveled off in the stretch. WATERLOO JUNCTION chased the pace off the rail, angled outward through the turn, entered the stretch six wide then leveled off while lugging in. STAR ELLEN chased the pace from the inside then steadied near the rail past the five sixteenths pole. BRIDGET T raced erratically and greenly.
