Footnotes

SIZZLING IRON saved ground early, made a three wide bid on the second turn, drifted in from right handed urging while gaining the lead at the top of the stretch, drew off in the final furlong. BOONE'S BAND set the early pace, was headed by PETE'S FLAIR on the backstretch, regained the lead, steadied at the top of the stretch, held on to the place. SISTER SOUL was in tight quarters passing the six furlong marker, settled off the pace, came up with a mild bid. PETE'S FLAIR raced forwardly, made a middle move to take the lead approaching the second turn, gave way. MISS RUTH raced three wide, was through early, passed tiring rivals late. NEGEV LADY slow early, advanced on the backstretch, could not maintain her rally. ANTHERIUM trailed for a half mile, was no factor. FANCHAZTIC was well placed to the backstretch, tired. DARINQUEST always four wide, showed little. A jockey's objection by the rider aboard BOONE'S BAND against SIZZLING IRON for alleged interference at the top of the stretch did not warrant any changes by the Stewards.
