TITAN LAUNCH broke in, rated a short lead inside, came under pressure at the five sixteenths pole and dug in under determined stretch handling to maintain. TODAY AND ALWAYS settled close about the three path, bid near the five sixteenths pole, had aim three wide rounding the final turn, dueled for place midstretch and finished evenly. BLACKBERRY WINTER stalked the pace two deep, had aim near the five sixteenths pole, was under a drive to maintain pursuit on the final turn but leveled off in midstretch. MR. KWOK broke out, settled back from the early pace inside, came under pressure at the half mile pole, improved at the rail rounding the final turn and finished evenly. DRESSED UP settled off the early pace toward mid track, bid from the three eighths pole then leveled off in the three path of the final turn. SIZZLING HOT raced well back toward the inside. BRADDOCK STREET broke a step slow and raced well back outside. ARSIERO settled off the pace off the rail, made a bid leaving the three eighths pole but lacked further response on the final turn. REBEL BOY was pinched back soon after the start and through after half.
